


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS






Use the panel holes as a template for positioning, and mark the holes on the wall.



Line up the panel holes with the holes of Part A and screw Part B into Part A by hand until snug. NOTE: Overtightening could cause substrates such as acrylic to crack. Do not use tools for this step as they may damage the finish of Part B.



If the wall is drywall or plaster, install the relevant plugs in the wall in the center of the marked holes on the wall. Insert the flat head screw through Part A and tighten either into the plug or into the center of the hole marked on the wall (depending on the wall type).
